

**Corrigendum: 1: A 2.3.4 Technical Area Expert - Surveying (SUR):**

For the above-mentioned technical area requirement, the educational qualifications specific to functional area may be read as following:

- i. Full time Degree/Diploma in Surveying from a Govt. recognized institute and having one-year post qualification experience in relevant field.
- ii. Desirable – Relevant trainings/ courses of 6 months duration and above. Valid Mines Surveyor's certificate of Competency from DGMS.

Other requirements remain the same.

**Corrigendum: 2: A 2.3.5 Technical Area Expert - Hydrogeology (HG):**

For the above-mentioned technical area requirement, the educational qualifications specific to functional area may be read as following:

- i. Master's (post-graduate) degree in Geology/ Applied Geology/ Hydrogeology/Hydrology/Water Resources Management from a UGC/AICTE recognized University/ Institution or equivalent.


Other requirements remain the same.

**Corrigendum: 3: Project Co-ordinator (PC) APA & MPPA Scheme:**

- i. For APA: A candidate meeting the requirements of this Scheme may apply for both, PC and TAE. Further, a Project Co-ordinator (PC) - Prospecting can apply for any one Technical Area other than Technical Area Expert (Geology).
- ii. For MPPA: A candidate meeting the requirements of this Scheme may apply for both, PC and Technical Area Expert (TAE). Further, a Project Co-ordinator (PC) – Mining can apply for any one Technical Area other than Technical Area Expert – Mining Engineer (ME).

**Corrigendum: 4: Minimum educational qualifications for experts:**

In exceptional cases the Accreditation Committee may waive off the minimum educational qualification for an expert based on the report and recommendation of assessors recording the rationale for the same.
