Other requirements remain the same.

Corrigendum: 2: A 2.3.5 Technical Area Expert - Hydrogeology (HG):

For the above-mentioned technical area requirement, the educational qualifications specific to functional area may be read as following:

 Master's (post-graduate) degree in Geology/ Applied Geology/ Hydrogeology/Hydrology/Water Resources Management from a UGC/AICTE recognized University/ Institution or equivalent.

Other requirements remain the same.

Corrigendum: 3: Project Co-ordinator (PC) APA & MPPA Scheme:

- i. <u>For APA:</u> A candidate meeting the requirements of this Scheme may apply for both, PC and TAE. Further, a Project Co-ordinator (PC) Prospecting can apply for any one Technical Area other than Technical Area Expert (Geology).
- ii. <u>For MPPA:</u> A candidate meeting the requirements of this Scheme may apply for both, PC and Technical Are Expert (TAE). Further, a Project Co-ordinator (PC) Mining can apply for any one Technical Area other than Technical Area Expert Mining Engineer (ME).

Corrigendum: 4: Minimum educational qualifications for experts:
