

SCHEME FOR ACCREDITATION OF EIA CONSULTANT ORGANIZATION

EMPANELMENT OF ACCREDITATION MEMBERS FOR THE NUCLEAR SECTOR UNDER EIA SCHEME

National Accreditation Board for Education & Training (NABET), a constituent board of the Quality Council of India (QCI) is operating the accreditation scheme for EIA consultant organizations. Ministry of Environment & Forests (MOEF&CC), Govt. of India has made it mandatory for EIA Consultants to get accredited under this Scheme. Consultant Organizations seeking accreditation for nuclear sector under the Scheme need to meet the requirements of having experts with defined qualifications and experience to be involved for preparing EIAs. Accreditation is granted by the Accreditation committee, which comprises of eminent persons. Apart from granting the accreditation to the consultant organization, the committee provides clarifications to some aspects of the Scheme as necessary from time to time. While Technical Committee guides NABET in developing the Scheme as well as the assessment process taking into consideration the feedback received from stakeholders/Accreditation Committee/Assessors et al.

NABET proposes to empanel Accreditation Committee Members for Nuclear Sector under the Scheme who meet the following requirements of qualification and experience –

1. Educational qualification –

- i. Bachelor's degree in engineering in Nuclear, Mechanical, Civil, Chemical, Electronics and Instrumentation, Mining and Environment and/or Master's degrees in Physics, Chemistry, Biology or alike
- ii. Membership of a professional body in her/his area/s of expertise will be an added advantage.

2. Experience –

- i. Should possess a minimum of 20 years of professional experience in relevant fields, including service at Nuclear Research Organizations, research and academic institutions related to Nuclear Science, Nuclear Energy Production, Fuel Cycle Organizations (like BARC, IGCAR, VECC, AMDER, NPCIL, NFC, HWB, SINP, IPR, TIFR, HBNI, AERB, CWRPS etc) or other reputed institutions.
- ii. Should have a good understanding of the EIA process and applicable rules & regulations to Nuclear Sector
- iii. Should have held senior positions in decision making level

3. Engagement- Member shall be appointed for a period of two (2) years extendable by another two years. In a year there may be 3-4 meetings (physical) or as and when required

Note:

- The expert should not be involved in any capacity in the process of making EIAs and must submit an undertaking to this effect.
- Candidate must also declare to the Board about association of his/her and/ or immediate family relative/s with any of the EIA Consultant Organization that can affect the impartiality of the assessment process.
- No telephone enquiries will be solicited.
